



## Town of Burns Harbor 2019 Budget & Tax Rates


The Burns Harbor Town Council held its public hearing for the 2019 Budget on September 12, 2018. There were no public comments or questions received. At its October 10, 2018 meeting, the Town Council approved its 2019 Budget, Resolution 2018-04, by a 5 – 0 vote. The State's Department of Local Government Finance (DLGF) approved the 2019 Budget and set final tax rates on December 27, 2018.

The Town of Burns Harbor's assessed value is \$577,298,101. The final taxes levied and tax rates for the Town of Burns Harbor (2018/pay 2019) are as follows:

**Burns Harbor has the lowest municipal tax rate in Porter County.**

Burns Harbor's 2019 tax rate including all taxing districts is \$2.0525, up from 2018. Of the \$2.0525, the Town receives 0.3740 cents per hundred, up 0.0022 cents from last year. The Duneland School District will receive \$1.0178, the County 0.4500, and the remainder is divided among the library, airport and township.



In addition to property tax supported Funds listed above, Burns Harbor has several Funds that are supported by other sources of revenue such as, intergovernmental revenue and taxes, licenses, permits, charges for services, fines, and grants. Below is Burns Harbor's 2019 budget for non-property tax supported Funds.
