



## Town of Burns Harbor 2017 Budget & Tax Rates

The Burns Harbor Town Council held its public hearing for the 2017 Budget on September 14, 2016. There were no public comments or questions received. At its October 12, 2016 meeting, the Town Council approved its 2017 Budget, Ordinance 2016-16, by a 4 – 0 – 1 abstention vote. The DLGF approved the 2017 Budget and set final tax rates on February 11, 2017.

The Town of Burns Harbor’s assessed value is \$565,127,972. The final taxes levied and tax rates for the Town of Burns Harbor (2016/pay 2017) are as follows:

**Burns Harbor has the lowest municipal tax rate in Porter County.**

Burns Harbor’s 2017 tax rate including all taxing districts is \$1.9428, down from 2016. Of the \$1.9428, the Town receives .3428 cents per hundred, up .0077 cents from last year. The Duneland School District will receive \$0.9660, the County .4385, and the remainder is divided among the library, airport and township.
